RESOLUTION 06-03-49-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE APPOINTMENT OF JOSEPH NAYQUONABE TO THE MINNESOTA INDIAN CHILD WELFARE ADVISORY COUNCIL

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Indian Child Welfare Advisory Council requires a resolution from the Mille Lacs Tribal government supporting the appointment of their Tribal representative to the Council; and,
- WHEREAS, each Tribe in Minnesota has a seat on the Minnesota Indian Child Welfare Advisory Board; and,
- WHEREAS, Joseph Nayquonabe is employed as the Director of Chemical Dependency/Social Services for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby appoints Joseph Nayquonabe to represent the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe on the Council.
- BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians wholeheartedly supports and endorses Joseph Nayquonabe as a member of the Minnesota Indian Child Welfare Advisory Council.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
