RESOLUTION 06-02-30-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A PROPOSAL SUBMITTED TO THE BUSH FOUNDATION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is committed to improving the general welfare of the Band by identifying education job opportunities, personal life skills on interrelated needs for all band members, and;
- WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by the partnership of Brainerd/Staples Technical College, Anishinabe Opportunities Industrialization Center (AOIC) and Fond Du Lac Opportunities Industrialization Center has been reviewed and the in-kind provisions is acceptable to the Band Assembly.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is in support of a proposal submitting to the Bush Foundation.
