RESOLUTION 06-03-74-95

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION TECHNOLOGY AND TRAINING PROJECT UNDER THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;

WHEREAS, the goal of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is to train Band Members and staff in environmental and historic preservation procedures and process within the boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the National Park Service has the necessary funds available to implement the project and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is desirous in obtaining funding for the Mille Lacs Reservation Technology and Training Project:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Band Assembly is in support of the Mille Lacs Reservation Technology and Training Project:
