RESOLUTION 06-03-50-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE AMERICAN INDIAN HOUSING CORPORATION PROJECT ANISHINABE WAKIAGUN, FOR HOMELESS AMERICAN INDIANS IN THE MINNEAPOLIS/URBAN AREA.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is a duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly is aware of the 10% homeless population of American Indians, representing most tribes in the upper Midwest, who need permanent housing and emergency services; and,

WHEREAS, the American Indian Housing Corporation is engaged in a variety of activities all designed to address the needs of American Indians, including the urban homeless population; and,

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has set aside funds under title IV of the Stewart B. McKinney Act that could be utilized by Indian Tribes for the homeless urban Indian Populations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly do hereby wholeheartedly supports the American Indian Housing Corporation in its plan to construct the forty (40) unit Anishinabe Wakiagun, a residence for homeless, alcoholic urban American Indians.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly, do hereby supports the request and proposals to be submitted to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, under the title IV, Stewart B. McKinney for funds to develop Anishinabe Wakiagun.
