RESOLUTION 06-02-32-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE/ NATIONAL INDIAN SAFE HOME COALITION DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM ON INJURY AND FIRE PREVENTION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band of Ojibwe Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, statistics point to injuries and house fires are the second largest killer of American Indian children, disabled, and the elderly; and
- WHEREAS, the National Indian Safe Home Coalition was formed to coordinate all federal agencies and national organizations having an interest in reducing injuries and deaths in Indian homes; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is desirous in obtaining technical and financial assistance to implement an Injury and Fire Prevention program on the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly shall provide assistance through the Commissioner of Administration in developing such a program; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the absence of the Commissioner of Administration, it is hereby authorized that the Assistant Commissioner of Administration be authorized to sign on behalf of the Commissioner of Administration.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
