**RESOLUTION 06-03-80-95**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MILLE LACS DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO NEGOTIATE THE ACQUISITION OF FRACTIONATED HEIRSHIP IN ALLOTMENTS WITH THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;

WHEREAS, THE Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have a policy on acquiring lands within the exterior boundaries of the Reservation for the benefit and improvement of member of the Band, and,

WHEREAS, the United States enacted an allotment policy to a lot lands to individual Band members within the Reservation, and,

WHEREAS, this allotment policy created the loss of Band lands, and,

WHEREAS, this allotment policy created fractionated heirship problems within the allotted lands, and,


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs enrollee [REDACTED] would like to sell his 23/84 interest in Mille Lacs Allotment 26, and,

WHEREAS, the acquisition would improve the land holdings of the Band and reduce the possibility of any more lands being lost.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby authorizes the Mille Lacs department of Natural Resources to negotiate the acquisition of fractional heirship in allotments within the Mille Lacs Reservation.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 30 day of March, 1995 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
