RESOLUTION 06-03-41-95

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS IN A NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON DRUG ABUSE (NIDA) FUNDED RESEARCH PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band of Ojibwe Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Band Assembly was advised of the proposed NIDA funded project to test an alcohol and drug prevention program among Native Americans within the Mille Lacs Band; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe believe that the band should pursue participation with final approval of participation in the proposed NIDA funded project.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approves participation of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe in the proposed NIDA funded research prevention of alcohol and drug abuse among Native Americans.
