RESOLUTION 06-03-61-95

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has mutually agreed to terminated land lease with the lessor, and homesite located at the following land description;

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Lot 3, Block 1, in Vineland Hills, Mille Lacs Reservation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians terminated this land lease effective February 7, 1995
