## RESOLUTION 06-03-42-95

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CREATION OF A PERMANENT INDIAN ELDER SPECIALIST POSITION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, during the '94 legislative session, the, Minnesota Indian Council of Elders with the support of the Minnesota Board on Aging and Indian Affairs Council sponsored a bill to create a permanent Indian Elder Specialist position on the Minnesota Board of Aging: and,
- WHEREAS, the bill passed the legislature but was included in the Health and Human Services Bill which was subsequently vetoed; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is aware that these organizations will again seek to establish the permanent Indian Elder Specialist position in the upcoming 1995 Legislative Session.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does hereby wholeheartedly supports and endorses the creation of a permanent Indian Eder Specialist position on the Minnesota Board of Aging.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
