RESOLUTION 06-02-25-95

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY OF THE DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO ALLOW USE OF THE COMMUNITY CENTERS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Band Statute 1141-MLC-2 Section 5 and Section 11.06, Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly "shall have the authority to regulate internal and external affairs of the Mille Lacs Band " and " to authorize the use of District community centers according to written standards that are fair and reasonable".
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly hereby adopt the following policy to allow use of the District Community Centers by Mille Lacs Band members and organizations according to the following conditions:
 - -use by organizations officially recognized or licensed by the Band (this does not mean that the Band agrees with the views expressed by organizations using the facilities, nor does it mean that those organizations express the views of the Band)
 - -the use of facilities shall not be denied for use by traditional cultural societies of the Band or for traditional Ojibwe ceremonies or official Pow Wows, or educational purposes.
 - -20 days written notice by individuals or organizations making such a request to allow for proper scheduling (unless an emergency, as determined by the District Representative, necessitates other arrangements)
 - -at the discretion of the District Representative, a damage or cleaning deposit of up to \$300 may be required
 - -under no circumstances will the facilities be used in the furtherance of any crime or criminal activity, nor will the facility be used for purposes causing disturbances, or for anything threatening the general peace, health, safety, culture or general welfare of the Band, its members or other persons on the reservation
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 2nd day of December, 1994 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, AGAINST, SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
