RESOLUTION 07-01-69-96

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE MILLE LACS BAND RESERVATION PARTICIPATION WITH THE LAKES AREA AFFILIATE OF HABITAT FOR HUMANITY AND THE CREATION OF A PLANNING COMMITTEE.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Band Assembly to improve the safety, living conditions and standards for all the people of the Mille Lacs Band; and,
- WHEREAS, the Habitat for Humanity International Foundation is a Christian Housing Ministry non-profit organization, with regional chapters that creates an all-volunteer Housing Construction program to build affordable housing for low income families across the United States.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby desires to wholeheartedly participate with the Lake Area Affiliate of Habitat for Humanity and supports the creation of a planning committee to implement a program on the Mille Lacs Reservation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
