
**A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]**

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, and;
- WHEREAS, the house has been abandoned for sometime and is a partially finished house, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Lot 1 (South 1/4 of Allotment A16) of Vineland Hills Addition that part of the south half of the NW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 43 North, Range 27 West, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly terminates this land lease effective July 9, 1996.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of July, 1996 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
