A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE HIV/AIDS PREVENTION PLANNING PROJECT AND APPROVAL OF SURVEY DOCUMENT.

- WHEREAS. the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly and Mille Lacs Reservation Department of Health and Human Services to improve the safety, living conditions and standards for all the people of the Mille Lacs Band: and.
- the Mille Lacs Band Assembly and the Mille Lacs Reservation Department of WHEREAS. Health and Human Services has heard the presentation by Ms Kelly Dagen, Coordinator for the Minnesota Department of Health HIV/STD Community Prevention Planning Projects.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does hereby desires to participate in the HIV/STD Prevention Planning with the Northeastern Minnesota Indian Reservations and the Minnesota Department of Health.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does hereby approves the implementation of 1996 HIV/STD Survey Document.
