RESOLUTION 06-04-26-96

**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT TO THE REQUEST TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AN "EXPERIMENTAL REDUCED-SPEED ZONE"**

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly has concerns for the safety and welfare of Band members as well as pedestrians and drivers who utilize the Band's facilities and Enterprises, and;
- WHEREAS, State Trunk Highway 169 is a major transportation artery which serves the Mille Lacs Reservation and dissects the District I community of Vineland; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Department of Public Works have met with the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MNDOT) and requested that the speed limit through the reservation specifically in front of the Grand Casino be reduced to 45 mph.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly supports the request to the Minnesota Department of Transportation for an "Experimental Reduced-Speed Zone" to be implemented along a one-mile stretch of State Trunk Highway 169 as it passes through the Mille Lacs Reservation.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 1st day of December, 1995 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of   2   FOR,   0   AGAINST,   0   SILENT.
