## **RESOLUTION 07-01-60-96**

	A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO
WHEREAS,	the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, and;
WHEREAS,	wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and;
WHEREAS,	tribal land lease are needed from the Band Assembly for the purpose of repayment of home loans-Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Home Loan Program in case of a default, and;
WHEREAS,	the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective March 21st, 1996, for the purpose of financing this home; and,
WHEREAS,	said land is described as follows:
	Block 1, Lot 20, Vineland Hills, Section 28 twp 43N, R27W, Mille Lacs Reservation Vineland Hills, in Mille Lacs county, according to the 1982 map.
NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective March 21st, 1996.
BE IT FURTH	ER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that lease will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, or if the leasee defaults on their home mortgage, this lease will then be assigned to the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Home Loan Program.
WE DO HERE	BY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 21st day of March, 1996 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of _2_ FOR,0_ AGAINST, _0 SILENT.
