RESOLUTION 07-01-54-96

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING WEST PUBLISHING COMPANY'S MILLE LACS BAND STATUTES ANNOTATED AS THE OFFICIAL PUBLICATION OF THE STATUTES OF THE MILLE LACS BAND

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is a federally recognized Indian tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 1141-MLC-2, Section 4.01, the Band Assembly possesses all of the Legislative political authority of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to 1141-MLC-2, Section 5.01, the Band Assembly is empowered to enact laws which promote the general welfare of the people, and;
- WHEREAS, West Publishing Company has undertaken and recently completed a codification of the Statutes of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, West has published the codified Band Statutes as Mille Lacs Band Statutes annotated, and;
- WHEREAS, legal counsel for the Band have reviewed the publication and recommended that the Band Assembly adopt and approve it.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby adopts and approves West's Mille Lacs Band statutes annotated, and any future amendments and editions thereto as the official publication of the statutes of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.


WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of March, 1996 at Lake Lena, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
