RESOLUTION 07-01-93-96

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE-TRIBAL EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING DEPARTMENT SUBMISSION OF A COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL PLAN UNDER TITLE IV-A SECTION 401 OF THE JOB TRAINING PARTNERSHIP ACT P.I. 97-300.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band recognizes the traditionally high unemployment rates on the Mille Lacs Reservation, have caused very serious social and economic problems, along with other forms of extreme hardships for the residents of the Mille Lacs Reservation Indian Community; and,
- WHEREAS, provide those Native American residents with the most needed employment and training activities to create a self-growth, independence, self-sufficiency, and;
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that such resources administered by the Tribal Employment & Training Department can indeed assist and lessen the negative effects of long term Welfare Dependency; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe recognizes the need for employment and Training activities consistent with the intent of Title IV-A Section 401 of the Job Training Partnership Act P.I. 97-300. It is the intent of the Band to operate the JTPA Program to support employability growth of the individual participants.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
