RESOLUTION 07-02-146-96

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A DEMONSTRATION GRANT PROPOSAL TO THE MINNESOTA BOARD ON AGING FOR NUTRITION SUPPORT SERVICES.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band is to improve the overall quality of life and health status of the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly respectfully requests funding assistance from the Minnesota Board on Aging to develop Nutrition Support Services in collaboration with the East Central Area Agency on Aging and Catholic Charities of St. Cloud; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band and its' collaborators desire to provide enhanced nutrition and nutrition support services to the members of the Band.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe does support its Health & Human Services Division, the East Central Area Agency on Aging and the Catholic Charities of St. Cloud in their application for funding to establish a home delivered meals, grocery and medication delivery, and nutrition education program in the Lake Lena District.


