RESOLUTION 07-01-101-96

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Tract 4- The East 200 feet of the South 200 feet of Government Lot 6, Section 18, Twp 43, Range 27, Mille Lacs County, State of MN Subject to road easement over the East 30 feet thereof. (Resolution 07-01-50-96)


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assemble terminate this land lease effective May 21, 1996.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 21st day of May, 1996 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
