**A RESOLUTION RECINDING RESOLUTION 04-02-89-90.**

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the following individual has signed a relinquishment form dated 10/12/89 and Resolution 04-02-89-90 was passed July 31, 1990, and;

WHEREAS, Fond Du Lac Resolution #2020/95 in which they rescind FDL Resolution 185/90 because Mr. Houle does not meet the requirements of enrollment in the Fond du Lac Band; and,

WHEREAS the Mille Lacs Band Assembly rescinds Resolution 04-02-89-90.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band, Mille Lacs Reservation rescinds Resolution 04-02-89-90 the relinquishment of Charles Allen Houle Jr. and recommends that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs make the required Transfer.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 15th day of May, 1996 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
