RESOLUTION 07-01-73-96

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, and:
- WHEREAS, wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and:
- WHEREAS, a tribal land lease is needed for the purpose of homesites on tribal lands for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the lease will be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective April 16, 1996 for the purpose of a homesite, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Shamrock twp 49N, R23W, in the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 in Section 32. Beginning at the NW corner of Lot 3, thence W 125' to NW corner of Lot 4, thence 200' S. to SE corner of Lot 4, thence 125' E. to SE. corner of Lot 4, thence N. 200' to point of beginning. All East and West line bearings are 99' 46" 5 seconds. Known as lot 4, Lake Minewawa District 2 Reservation.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective April 16, 1996.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will then revert back to the Band.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the leasee abandon or vacate the above described property for more than thirty (30) days without the prior approval of the Band Assembly.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 18th day of April, 1996 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
