A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING GREAT LAKE INDIAN FISH & WILDLIFE ANA GRANT

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe realizes the importance of teaching our youth the traditional methods of management, protection, and utilization of our natural resources; and,
- WHEREAS, it is critical that resource management and treaty rights information be disseminated to the wided possible constituency which can be accomplished be establishment of a Internet web site.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe endorses and supports Great Lake Indian Fish & Wildlife Commission's application to the Administration of Native Americans to address these important initiatives.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
