RESOLUTION 07-01-89-96

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR WHEREAS. the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, and; WHEREAS. the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc. and: WHEREAS. who entered into a lease agreement with the Mille Lace Band dated July 16, 1992, has requested an additional lot, and; WHEREAS. said land is described as follows: Block 1, Lot 2, Vineland Hills addition, part of So 1/2 of NW 1/4 Section 28, twp 43 N, R27 W. Mille Lacs County. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians terminated this land lease effective May 9th, 1996. WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of May, 1996 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.

IN CONCURRENCE, with the action of the Speaker of Assembly, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Chief Executive to this resolution.
