RESOLUTION 07-01-75-96

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SUBMITTING A GRANT PROPOSAL WHICH IN PART SUPPORTS TRIBAL CULTURAL ACTIVITIES.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band of Ojibwe Indians is a federaly-recognized Indian Tribe; and.
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Education Division ("Cultural and Spiritual Heritage Committee") of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has been working with the Association on American Indian Affairs in furthering Ojibwe Cultural Education; and,
- WHEREAS, the Association is submitting a grant proposal which in part supports Tribal cultural activities including Sacred Sites Protection to the Administration for Native Americans (ANA); and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly, on behalf of the Cultural Committee, herein gives its support to the grant proposal submitted by the Association to ANA.
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does hereby wholeheartedly gives support to the grant proposal submitted by the Association to ANA.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
