RESOLUTION 07-02-17-97

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe, and;

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required for the purposes of a homesite, any commercial activity or acquiring financing for a home on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] respectfully requests the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite. and,

WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective November 27th, 1996, for the purpose of a homesite, and

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Section 20, TWP 43 N, R 27 W. That part of West one half of the Northwest one Quarter of the Northwest one Quarter of the Southwest one Quarter of the Southwest one Quarter of the Southwest one Quarter; Subject to a 50.01 ft Easterly right of way along County State AID Highway No. 25. This is a 5 acre Parcel of which approximately 60% is to low to Build; in Mille Lacs County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective November 27th, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that lessee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, it will revert back to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a Special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 27th day of November, 1996 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
