RESOLUTION 07-04-111-97

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, MINNESOTA PLANNING, AND MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN FAMILIES AND LEARNING, FOR YOUTH PROGRAMS ON THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Administration and Commissioner of Health and Human Services are authorized to sign State grants and contracts, on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe support and wholeheartedly endorse proposals to benefit at-risk youth on the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forward to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
