RESOLUTION 07-03-37-97

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY DIVISION, FOR AN ADOLESCENT CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY WORKER.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a Federally- recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Adolescent Chemical Dependency Worker is to help reduce problems and incidents associated with adolescent alcohol and drug abuse on the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Adolescent Chemical Dependency Worker will be a staff member of the Chemical Dependency/Mental Health/Domestic Violence Division, within the Mille Lacs Band Department of Health and Human Services.; and,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby supports wholeheartedly and endorses the submission of the proposal to the Minnesota Department of Human Services, Chemical Dependency Division, for an Adolescent Chemical Dependency Worker.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
