RESOLUTION 07-0 4-116-97

	A RESOLUTION TERMINATING A LAND LEASE TO (DECEASED) AND
WHEREAS,	the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
WHEREAS,	tribal land leases are required for the purposes of a homesite, agricultural and seasonal recreational residence, any commercial activity or acquiring financing for a home on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs reservation, and;
WHEREAS,	the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;
WHEREAS,	said land described as follows: Starting at the SW corner of the SE ¼ of NW ¼ of Section 1, T42N, R25W, hence due east along township road a distance of 300 feet to point of beginning, hence 200 feet north, hence 200 feet east, hence 200 feet south, hence 200 feet west to point of beginning, Mille Lacs County, Isle Harbor Township; and,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly terminates this land lease to resolution 04-04-03-92) effective August 21, 1997.	
WE DO HERE	BY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 21st day of August, 1997

at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of <u>2_FOR,0_AGAINST, 0_SILENT</u>.
