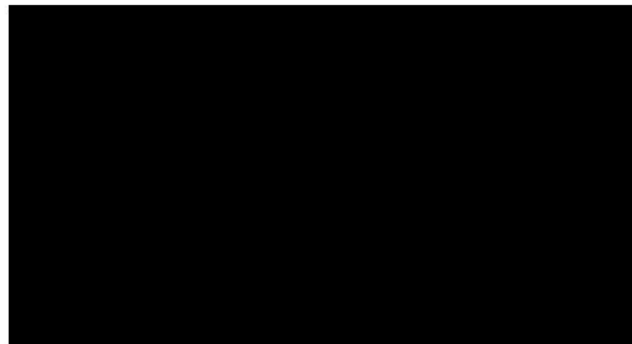
RESOLUTION 07-02-23-97

does meet the requirements for enrollment into the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.


