RESOLUTION 07-0 4-121-97

A RESOLUTION TERMINATING A LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required for the purposes of a homesite, agricultural and seasonal recreational residence, any commercial activity or acquiring financing for a home on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs reservation, and;


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;

WHEREAS, said land described as follows: Beginning at a point on the shore of Mille Lacs Lake 1,125 ft. East of the Northwest Corner of Government 3, thence South 76 ft. to an iron monument, thence West 100 ft. to the point of beginning, thence West 100 ft., thence South 200 ft., thence East 100 ft., thence North 200 ft. to the point to beginning. Mille Lacs County, State of Minnesota. Also, a 15-foot Right of Way Easement along the East line of Said Lot described, to gain access to a Lot on back of the above-described property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly terminates this land lease to [REDACTED] (resolution 05-02-84-92) effective September 9, 1997

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of September, 1997 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT
