## **RESOLUTION 07-02-14-97**

## A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, and:
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: That part of the Beginning at the SE
  Corner of Lot 42, thence north 200 ft, thence East 175 feet, thence South to
  Road, 200 feet, thence West to point of beginning all in Section 1, twp 42 N, R 25
  W, and access thereto, District 2 MilleLacs Reservation, Mille lacs County, State of
  Minnesota. (Resolution 06-03-99-95)
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly terminate this land lease effective October 24, 1996.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the <u>24th</u> day of October, 1996 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of <u>2</u> FOR, <u>0</u> AGAINST, <u>0</u> SILENT.
