RESOLUTION 07-03-72-97

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION REQUESTING FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE: BUREAU OF JUSTICE STATISTICS FOR THE PILOT PROJECT: TRIBAL CRIMINAL CASE TRACKING SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is concerned for its enrolled members,

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice: Bureau of Justice Statistics provides for funding available to assist Indian tribes in financing programs which are designed to aid in the development and implementation of criminal case tracking systems, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is desirous in obtaining such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby supports the submission of a proposal to the Department of Justice: Bureau of Justice Statistics for the Pilot Project: Tribal Criminal Case Tracking System.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forward to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
