RESOLUTION 07-03-59-97

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE GREAT LAKES INDIAN FISH AND WILDLIFE COMMISSION (GLIFWC) PROPOSAL FOR FUNDING TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS (ANA).

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the proposal and its intent and find it to be in the best interest to the Mille Lacs Band.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does hereby support and authorize the Great Lakes Indian Fish and Wildlife Commission to submit the proposal to the ANA for the purposes of funding the following mandates:

* Establish an Anishinabe Intertribal policy position on off-reservation trust responsibilities within the 1836, 1837 and 1842 Chippewa ceded territories; and,

* Develop an Anishinabe off-reservation environmental monitoring system to ascertain environmental risks for hard rock mineral development within the 1837 and 1842 ceded territories; and,

* to critique the application and the accuracy of the commonly applied IMPLAN economic model in measuring economic benefits and environmental costs, including exercise of off-reservation treaty rights, for GLIFWC member tribes likely to be impacted by mining proposals.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 6th day of March, 1997 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
