## **RESOLUTION 08-01-103-98**

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MINO AYAA BIMODIZII WIN FOUNDATION, A NONPROFIT CORPORATE BODY POLITIC AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE TRIBAL HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN, ENTITLED "CIRCLE OF HEALTH".

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is authorized by 16 MLBSA § 2101 (b), to organize such a Nonprofit Corporate Body Politic; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band is desirous of providing health care coverage for all Mille Lacs Band members.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby wholeheartedly supports and endorses the development of the Mino Ayaa Bimodizii Win Foundation as a Nonprofit Corporate Body Politic; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Band Assembly is fully supportive of establishing the Circle of Health Tribal Health Insurance Plan.
