RESOLUTION 08-02-133-98

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL FOR A HEAD START GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly respectfully requests funding assistance from the Head Start Bureau to strengthen the care of our children.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe does hereby approve the submission of a proposal for assistance to the Department of Health and Human Services Administration of Children, Youth and Families, Head Start Bureau.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Education are hereby authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that in the absence of the Commissioner of Administration, it is hereby authorize that the Assistant Commissioner of Administration be authorize to sign on behalf of the Commissioner Administration.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forward to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
