RESOLUTION 07-04-16-98

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL TO THE UNITED STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, RURAL DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY FACILITY GRANT PROGRAM, FOR A BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB FACILITY ON THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby supports and endorses the submission of the 1998 proposal to the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development Community Facility Grant Program, for a Boys and Girls Club Facility on the Mille Lacs Reservation;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby supports wholeheartedly and endorses the submission of the 1998 proposal to the United State Department of Agriculture for a Boys and Girls Club Facility on the Mille Lacs Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Health and Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; and,

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that in the absence of the Commissioner of Administration, it is hereby authorized that the Assistant Commissioner of Administration be authorized to sign on behalf of the Commissioner of Administration.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, we, the Administration Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forward to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
