RESOLUTION 08-01-57-98

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND SUPPORTING THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION- CULTURAL ACTIVITIES PROJECT.

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band Assembly is a duly- elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized tribe; and,

whereas, the goal of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians is to preserve and document cultural activities that once dominated the lives of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe. Arts and Crafts, gathering activities, language, song and dance are integral to the culture and beliefs of these people.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians Prepare an application and proposal to the **Minnesota Historical Society**, to fund this worthwhile project.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Natural Resources are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Chief Executive hereunto set my hand to be affixed to this resolution and forward to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
