RESOLUTION 08-01-84-98

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE DESIRES TO HAVE ACQUIRED FEE LAND PLACED IN TRUST WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally recognized Indian tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe has acquired land within the exterior boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation for a number of purposes, such as hunting, fishing, and gathering, as well as for recreational development and cemetery use.
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe wishes to have this land transferred to the United States and be placed in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.
- NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to accept and place the following land to be put in trust for the benefit of the Mille Lacs Band:

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), and Four (4), Block B, Walser, said plat being situated on Government Lot Five (5) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Forty-three (43), Range Twenty-seven (27), West of the 4th PM (Said Government Lot Five (5), also being the Fractional SW ¼ of the SW ¼); Mille Lacs County, Minnesota.

- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of April, 1998 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for concurrence.
