## **RESOLUTION 08-01-107-98**

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE IN SUPPORT OF JULIE SHINGOBE OBTAINING AN "EMINENCE TEACHING LICENSE".

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, Julie Shingobe is in the process of obtaining an "Eminence Teaching License"; and,
- WHEREAS, she is knowledgeable, has achieved and demonstrated competence in the Ojibwe language and culture; and,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly attests to Julie Shingobe's knowledge, achievement and demonstrated competence in the Ojibwe language and culture.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe does support Julie Shingobe in her efforts in obtaining an "Eminence Teaching License".
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June 1998 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST. 0 SILENT.
