RESOLUTION 08-01-104-98

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE MILLE LACS BAND DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR THE SECTION 202 SUPPORTIVE HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and.
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band is desirous to build Assisted Living Facilities for Elders on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and has committed and appropriated \$896,000 for this purpose; and,
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe hereby wholeheartedly supports and endorses the submission of a proposal to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Section 202 Supportive Housing Program.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the Chief Executive, hereunto recommend and affix my signature to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
