A RESOLUTION GRANTING TRANSFER OF ENROLLMENT INTO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION, FROM THE LEECH LAKE RESERVATION OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE.


- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all memberships considerations and has reviewed the following application for transfers from the Leech Lake Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the following individuals are eligible due to their blood quantum and their ancestral background:


