RESOLUTION 07-04-08-98

A RESOLUTION DENYING THE ENROLLMENT INTO THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the following application for enrollment; and,

do not meet the requirements for enrollment into the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly denies the above application for enrollment due to their ancestral background.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of October, 1997 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
