## **RESOLUTION 08-02-131-98**

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE INDIANS FOR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY OUTREACH PROGRAM CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly respectfully accepts funding assistance from the State of Minnesota Department of Human Services to provide programs and services to address chemical dependency needs.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe does hereby approve the terms of the grant contract entered into between the State of Minnesota and the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe for Fiscal Years 1998 and 1999; and,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Health and Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-removal Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
