RESOLUTION 07-04-51-98

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE IN SUPPORT OF NORMAN CLARK OBTAINING AN "EMINENCE TEACHING LICENSE".

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, Norman Clark is in the process off obtaining an "Eminence Teaching License"; and,

WHEREAS, he is knowledgeable, has achieved and demonstrated competence in the Ojibwe language and culture,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly attest to Norman Clark's knowledge, achievement and demonstrated competence in the Ojibwe language and culture.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe does support Norman Clark in his efforts in obtaining an "Eminence Teaching License".

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a Special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 10th day of December 1997 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST. 0 SILENT.
