## **RESOLUTION 08-02-16-99**

## A RESOLUTION TERMINATING A LAND LEASE

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are required for the purposes of a homesite, agricultural and seasonal recreational residence, any commercial activity or acquiring financing for a home on all tribal lands of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

That part of the S1/2SE1/4SW1/4, Section 7, township 43 North, Rage 27 West, Kathio Township North, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota, beginning at the section line post marker on Hwy 2, thence W 400 feet along Hwy 2 on White fish Lake, the point of beginning, thence North 250 feet, thence West 150 feet, thence South 250 feet, thence East 150 feet, to the pint of beginning and there terminating.

Cancellation requested by Lessor due to non-use of the site by Lessee and existence of another residential lease in the name of the Lessee.

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly terminates this land lease (Resolution 07-02-122-96) effective December 4, 1998.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 4th day of December 1998 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Chief Executive for Concurrence.
