## **RESOLUTION 08-03-67-99**

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL TO THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, FOR A RURAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND CHILD VICTIMIZATION ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM (RURAL PROGRAM)

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe, and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Department of Justice Programs: Rural program provides for funding available to assist Indian tribes in financing programs which are designed to aid in the development and implementation of safety for women and children; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is concerned for improving direct services for families who have experienced domestic violence.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby supports the submission of a proposal to the Department of Justice Programs: Rural Domestic Violence and Child Victimization Enforcement Grant Program.
