## **RESOLUTION 08-03-39-99**

## A RESOLUTION REQUESTING TO ADD THE FOLLOWING ROADS TO THE BIA PRIORITY LIST.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have contracted under the provisions of the P.L. 93-638 to conduct transportation planning activities; and,
- WHEREAS, some roads on the Mille Lacs Reservation have been identified which are not currently on the BIA priority list but should be.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly requests the following roads located on the Mille Lacs Reservation be added to the BIA priority list:

Route 0060 located in Section 18, T. 43N, R. 27W, having a length of approximately 0.2 miles.

Route 0061 located in Section 17, T. 43N, R. 27W, having a length of approximately 1.0 miles.

Route 0062 located in Section 1, T. 42N, R. 25W, having a length of approximately 0.75 miles.

Route 0055 located in Section 30, T. 43N, R. 27W, having a length of approximately 1.3 miles.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council, a quorum of legislators being present held on the \_26thday of January, 1999 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of \_2\_FOR, \_0\_AGAINST, \_0\_SILENT.
