## Resolution 08-03-38-99

## A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE TODIANS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TITLE VI – ELDERLY NUTRITION PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Administration on Aging has financial resources available to provide social and nutritional services to the Elderly, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians has a desire to continue participating in the Nutrition Program for the Elderly, and;
- WHEREAS, this is a 3-year project starting April 1, 1999 to March 31, 2002.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians has prepared an application and proposal for continued funding for the Title VI Nutrition Program for the Elderly pursuant to the regulation requirement of the program.
- IN WITNESS THEREOF, I, the Chief Executive hereunto set my hand to be affixed to this resolution and forward to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
