RESOLUTION 08-03-80-99

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ENROLLMENT INTO THE MILLE LACS BAND MILLE LACS RESERVATION, DUE TO AN INCREASE IN THEIR BLOOD QUANTUM.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly-elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe, a federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly screens all membership considerations and has reviewed the following applications for enrollment; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the applications to reconsider the blood quantum for [redacted] d.o.b. [redacted] and [redacted] d.o.b. [redacted].

WHEREAS, Based on the order issued by the U.S. Dept of Interior for [redacted] and an enrollment card for [redacted] family tree for [redacted] their blood quantum will be increased from [redacted]

WHEREAS, the resolution denying [redacted] is Resolution 05-04-06-94, dated October 8, 1993.

WHEREAS, the changes should be made on the records of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approves the above applications for enrollment and approves all rights provided for the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe enrollees.


WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of July, 1999 at Hinckley, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
