RESOLUTION 08-03-40-99

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING TO ADD TO THE BIA INVENTORY LIST.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe; a Federally-recognized Indian Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe have contracted under the provisions of the P.L. 93-638 to conduct transportation planning activities; and,
- WHEREAS, in order to identify and more effectively identify the transportation needs of the Reservation, a new road construction priority needs to be established.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly do hereby establish the following priorities for road construction projects

Route 0060 located in Section 18, T. 43N, R. 27W, having a length of approximately 0.2 miles, grade, drain, gravel base.

Route 0061 located in Section 17, T. 43N, R. 27W, having a length of approximately 1.0 miles, clear, grade, drain, gravel base and bituminous surface. Route 0062 located in Section 1, T. 42 N, R. 25W, having a length of approximately 0.75 miles, clear, grade, drain, gravel base and bituminous surface.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 13th day of January, 1999 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of _2_FOR, _0_AGAINST, _0_SILENT.
